

### WHAT IS A SAFETY AND SECURITY DECLARATION (S&S)?

Safety and Security declaration (S&S) is also known as an Entry Summary declaration (ENS). Its purpose is to inform border authorities, so they can analyse the potential risk caused to their territory by goods crossing their border.

# WHEN DO WE NEED TO START COMPLETING SAFETY AND SECURITY DECLARATIONS (S&S)?

From the 31st of October 2024.

The S&S completion time before the goods arrive in the UK, is usually 2 hours. But it does depend on the mode of transport. <u>Full breakdown of S&S completion timings</u>

## WHOSE RESPONSIBILITY IS IT THAT THESE SAFETY AND SECURITY DECLARATIONS (S&S) GET COMPLETED?

It is the legal responsibility of the carrier (also defined as the operator of the active means of transport), to make sure that Safety and Security declarations get completed.

If your goods are driver accompanied, it's the haulier's responsibility.

If your goods are driver unaccompanied, it's the carrier's responsibility.

It is worth pointing out that the carrier can defer the responsibility of creating the S&S to the booking party. At which point the carrier only needs to make sure a S&S has been completed, and its up to the booking party to complete the S&S and advise the carrier.

# WHO CAN COMPLETE SAFETY AND SECURITY DECLARATIONS (S&S)?

A third party (like RJJ Freight) can act on the haulier's or carrier's behalf to complete safety and security declarations with their consent.





## WHAT INFORMATION IS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A SAFETY AND SECURITY DECLARATION (S&S)?

Information wise, its very similar to completing an import customs declaration.

Please see below complete list of everything required:

Total number of Packages and number of packages for each commodity	Package Type (box, cartons etc)
Goods Description	Gross Mass
HS code (4 digits only)	<u>UN Dangerous goods code (If applicable)</u>
Consignor	Consignee
Port of Loading	Port of Discharge
Trailer Number/Container number	Seal number
Arrival date and time	Mode of Transport (air, sea, land, rail or roro)
Transport document number (airwaybill, bill of lading or CMR)	List of countries routing
Customs office of entry	Transport charges or method of payment
Declarant's EORI and Carrier's EORI	Declaration date and place
Notify Party	Carrier
Conveyance ref number (not required for RORO shipments)	Packaging marks and numbers
